Warm Greetings From Nepal Fencing Association.

We would like to inform you that on April 25 a massive earthquake in the 7.9 in the Richter scale rocked Nepal and was followed by over 200 aftershocks. The devastating earthquake which first struck at 11:55 am on Saturday ruined numerous houses, temples, historical building and monuments, including UNESCO heritage site. Till date around more than 8,500 people lost their lives, more than 15,000 people are injured and millions people were homeless.

In the meantime, we have lost some of our sports infrastructures, such as only two International Standard Swimming Pools and only international Covered Hall are completely useless.
