5. Participation

- The host country may enter a maximum of 64 fencers, while other countries are limited to a maximum of 20 fencers. Fencers from other continents are welcome and will be subjected to the same conditions to participate. All fencers must endorsed by their federations.
- All participating fencers must be at least 13 years old and not be more than 16 years of age on December 31 of the year 2019.
- All participating fencers must have a valid Asian license for the season of 2019 to 2020, issued by the FCA. Cadet fencers must register with the FCA to apply for such license and pay an annual fee of US\$15 to the FCA. Please confirm the procedure at each federation office.

6. Entry and Fees

- a) To participate in any Asian cadet competition, all participating fencers must be endorsed by their federations.
- b) Cadet fencers with valid Asian license interested to participate ACC must register through the FCA website by 22 July, 2019, to participate the ACC cadet circuit in Iwakuni.
- c) Participating cadet fencers should pay an Entry Fee directly to the organizers of the competition, at the venue. The **entry fee to be paid is US\$40** per individual fencer.

7. Equipment/Uniforms:

- Fencers must use standard FIE uniforms/equipment (800 NW for clothing, 1600 NW masks, 800 NW under garment/plastron, FIE homologated blades).
- No name on the back of the fencer's clothing is required. Uniforms with markings other than of the official federation (such as schools, clubs) may be allowed.
- Weapon Check will be conducted on the pistes, before the matches.
- Equipment shop will be available in the Gymnasium.

8. Points and Ranking:

- Please refer to the Policy of Asian Cadet Circuit of FCA website;
 FCA website /Documents/Policies/ACC
- No points shall be awarded in competitions where there are less than 3 Asian/Oceania countries
 and less than 30 participants (among them at least 30% foreigners). FCA shall be responsible
 for tabulating the overall Asian cadet ranking based on the points awarded during the
 competition.

9. Referees/Officials:

 Participating countries must be accompanied by qualified referees based on the following quota:

1 - 4 fencers no referee required

5-9 fencers, 1 referee

10 – 15 fencers, 2 referees

16 – 20 fencers, 3 referees

• The federations who will send accompanied referees, please inform the name(s) of referee and eligible weapon to the organizer, by 3weeks before the date of the competition.

• Non respect of referee quota is sanctioned by US\$500 for every missing referee.

Qualified referees are those with good national or international level qualification and experience.

 The Host country shall provide at least two (2) FIE licensed referees coming from different countries. FCA shall designate one official Referee Delegate from among the participating referees.

10. Formula of Competition:

- Generally, the FIE technical and competition rules are to be respected.
 When it is necessary to modify or to change the formula, DT will announce the change by 6:00 p.m. the day before the competition.
- From the round preceding the ED table, a minimum of 20% and a maximum of 25% of participations shall be eliminated

11. Competition Method

The fencing competition shall be conducted in accordance with the current Statutes and Rules of the FIE. In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules, the latest English version shall prevail. The *Directoire Technique*(DT) shall deal with any unforeseen incidents not covered by the Rules.

12. Awards:

Organizers shall provide all participants with a Certificate of Participation and a Diploma to the top 8 placers in each event. The top 4 placers in each event shall also be provided with medals by the FCA.

15. Accommodation

Organizer recommends to book following hotels, however you may arrange by yourself to find other rooms/hotels in town. There are no differences on conditions.

To book above hotels, please contact our designated travel agent who has blocked some quantity of rooms for the fencers. The price include breakfast, service-charges and tax per person. Please contact fencing-support@keio-kanko.co.jp for support, by sending an attached application form.

When arrangement of accommodation is made through this designated agent, payment should be by credit card only. For other payment, please consult to the agent.

13. Transportation from/to Airport:

- Air travel: The most close airport is Iwakuni Airport, but when you take an international air travel to Fukuoka, in Kyushu, JR Shinkansen will be good to come to JR Shin-Iwakuni Sta.
 From JR Shin-Iwakuni Sta.to Iwakuni city will be 20 min. ride by taxi.
- The Airport Shuttle Bus service is available from Iwakuni Airport to Iwakuni JR Station (West Gate). Hotels with number ① to ③ are close to the JR station, in 3 to 10 min. walk. The shuttle bus fee is 200 yen per person, one way.

14. Transportation from hotel to the venue:

- Unfortunately, we cannot provide the transportation from/to hotels to the venue.
- Please call taxi(s) from your hotel to arrange. The taxi fees are likely followings: From JR Iwakuni Sta. area to the venue; 1500~2000 yen with 10~15 min. ride.

15. Language

The official language for the event is English.

16. Entry Formalization and VISA

Everyone entering Japan from abroad must possess valid passports, participants are recommended to check with their local Japanese Embassy/Consulate for visa requirements before traveling.
