2024 - Olympic Asian Qualifying Championship – April 2024, UAE - approved

2024 - Asian Juniors and Cadets Fencing Championships –2024, Jordan - approved

2024 - Asian Under 23 Fencing Championships October –2024, Iraq - approved

2024 - Asian Masters (Veterans) Fencing Championships – 2024, Hong Kong - approved

We now call on all interested National Federations & Associations to submit their Bids for the hosting of the following competitions:

2025, 2026 Asian Juniors and Cadets Fencing Championships (dates of organization end of February – first decade of March).

2024, 2025, 2026 Asian Fencing Championship, Seniors (dates of organization month of June 2024, 2025, 2026).

2024 Candidate to Seniors Asian Fencing Championship is Kuwait.

2025, 2026 Asian Masters (Veterans) Fencing Championships (dates of organization month of August 2025, 2026).

2025, 2026 Asian Under 23 Fencing Championships (dates of organization within October till November 2025, 2026).

2024, 2025, 2026 Asian Cadet Fencing Cups (dates of organization within April 2024/2025/2026 till February 2025/2026/2027).

Interested Federations & Associations must submit the Bidding and send it to the FCA before September 20th, 2023, with their letter of Intent indicating therein the proposed city and dates of the competitions, as well as their commitment to host any of the above competitions in conformity with the "Policies" (that you will find on the website of FCA or request from the FCA Head office).
