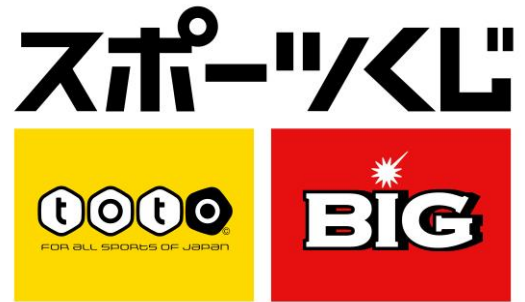

4. **Schedule of the Competition :** Grades 5 and 6 : Men,Women Foil, Epee, Sabre

Grades 3 and 4 : Men,Women Foil

* Note: Fencers in grades 5 and 6 can participate in individual matches for up to two weapons. However, since epee and sabre matches will be held simultaneously, he or she can only choose either one of them.

5. **Qualification:**

- 1) Open to all fencers who were born between April 2, 2012 – April 2, 2015.
- 2) For participants from overseas, up to 8 fencers from each country can be entered per weapon and per gender.
- 3) No fencer is accepted to take part in the competition unless he or she is entered by his/her own national federation.
- 4) Fencers, bench coaches and bench supervisors are required to be registered to their own national federations.

6. Entry Fee: JPY 10,000 (Registration fee JPY 5,000 + Entry fee JPY 5,000)

The fees are to be paid at the accreditation desk during the competition.

Only cash payment in JPY is acceptable.

7. Application for an entry :

- 1) Fill in the entry form and send it to the following email address attached with passport photos.

- 2) Period: July 30 – Aug 8, 2024
- 3) The entry form must be sent by a national federation from the email address that is registered to FIE.
- 4) After Aug 8, we only accept entry until July 15 if you pay triple the amount (JPY 30,000 for individual). The penalties are also to be paid at the accreditation desk during the competition
- 5) Fencers, bench coaches and bench supervisors need to provide a document which confirms their registration of the national federation when sending the entry

9. Rules of the Competition :

- 1) While complying with FIE regulations, we apply the clothing and mask rules as below.

- The use of newly approved mask (attached with double safety belt) is required. 350N masks can also be used. Fleurette will wear a mask with metal bib.
 - The use of a breast/chest protector 800N with an official FIE mark is required.
 - A fencing uniform which ensures a resistance to penetration equal or greater than 350 Newtons is required
 - 3rd and 4th grade must use No. 3 swords or smaller.
 - 5th and 6th grade players must use a No. 5 sword or smaller.
 - Blades do not have to be FIE approved.
 - Body cords must use transparent plugs.
 - At epee and sabre, the use of the plastic breast protector is compulsory for women.
 - At foil, the use of a breast/chest protector covered with a soft material is compulsory for women and optional for men
- At epee and sabre, the use of a conventional chest protector is optional for men.
- At sabre, the use of FIE certified sabre gloves or FIE certified gloves with cuffs is compulsory.

Chapter 4 THE FENCER'S EQUIPMENT (Weapons — Equipment — Clothing)

t.20-1 Fencers arm, equip and clothe themselves and fence at their own responsibility and at their own risk."

Fencers must fully understand that they would be responsible for any accidents in which they are either a perpetrator or a victim.

3) Formula

grades 3 and 4 Men, Women Foil	<ul style="list-style-type: none">•Consists of the poules and the direct elimination•Poule bouts are fenced to 5 points•The elimination round matches are fenced in two periods of three minutes each to 8 points•There is no match for third place
grades 5 and 6 Men, Women Foil,Epee,Sabre	<ul style="list-style-type: none">•Consists of the poules and the direct elimination•Poule bouts are fenced to 5 points•The elimination round matches are fenced in two periods of three minutes each to 10 points•There is no match for third place

4) Safety Management

- Participants must ensure their safety during the competition.
- During the lesson, coaches must wear a fencing uniform under a coaching gilet without a sleeve. There is no need for a fencing uniform when wearing a coaching gilet with sleeves.
- The organizers cannot take responsibility for any injuries that occur during the match.

Athletes agree that photographs and digital data of participants at the competition may be used by FJE or by parties authorized by FJE.
