1. Age Category:

(A) **Age: 40 - 49 (as of 31 December 2025)**

For women, age 35-49 (as of 31 December 2025)

Note: age 35-39 are not included in the World Veteran Championships selection.

(B) **Age: 50 – 59 (as of 31 December 2025)**

(C) **Age: 60 – 69 (as of 31 December 2025)**

(D) **Age: 70 or older (as of 31 December 2025)**

2. Qualification: Those who meet one of the following conditions:

- Regardless of nationality, individuals who have completed membership registration (FY2025) with Federation Japonaise d'Escrime (FJE)
- For foreign fencers, holders of their country's license or FIE license

3. Registration:

4. Registration Period: From 2 June 2025 to 12 June 2025

5. Entry Fee

- a. The entry fee is 6,000 yen (or US\$50) per event. 12,000 yen (or US\$100) for 2 events, 18,000 yen (or US\$150) for 3 events
- b. Participants from overseas can pay at check-in on the day of the event (cash only)

6. Competition:

- a. Age categories (A) and (B) will compete as “Veterans”, and (C) and (D) will be compete as “Grand Veterans” in pool competitions (by event).

*The categories of team competition scheduled for the 2025 World Veteran Championships are; “Veterans” are (A) & (B) and “Grand Veterans” are (C) & (D).

- b. Direct elimination matches (tournament matches) will be held in each age category.
- c. Pool matches of 3 minutes and first to 5 points, followed by a tournament match (the Direct Elimination match) of 2 sets of 3 minutes (5 points break for sabre) and first to 10 points.
- d. A third-place game will be held in all categories in order to determine ranking points.
However, this will not be held for fencers under age 40 or foreign fencers.
- e. 5th place and below up to 16th place will be determined by the results of the Direct elimination matches.
- f. In principle, all fencers shall proceed to the Direct Elimination matches. However, if there are significantly more participants than in previous years, a maximum of 30% fencers of the bottom of the pool results may not proceed to the Direct Elimination matches.
- g. The DT will decide how to respond to delays, changes in requirements, or other unscheduled changes due to various reasons.

7. Competition Rules:

The competition rules will be based on the latest FIE rules.

*Unwillingness to fight (Non-combativity)

Note that the non-combativity rule (t.124) introduced in December 2018 has been changed in December 2022. (P-yellow and P-red are issued to both players irrespective of the score difference, and a third non-combativity will result in P-black and an immediate end to the match.)

- b. As a special exception, uniforms (top and bottom) 350N are also allowed.

9. Awards:

Medals will be awarded to 1st through 3rd place in each event, and certificates to 4th through 8th place.
